Japan's Rules of the Road

Everyone can make this "a safe place for cycling"

Kagawa Prefecture is promoting safe cycling through the establishment of rules for safe bicycle use. Let's share the roads with cars, pedestrians, and other bicycles with mutual respect and understanding.

- In principle, bicycles should ride on the roads, and on sidewalks only when necessary.
- Ride on the left side of the road.
- Yield to pedestrians on sidewalks, staying close to the road.
- Follow all safety rules.
 - No cycling under the influence of alcohol, cycling with extra passengers, or parallel riding.
 - Use your lights from 30 minutes before sunset.
 - Stop and follow signals at intersections.
 - Don't use your phone while riding.
- Helmet Use
Helmets can save your life. Fasten and tighten your chin strap so it's snug!

Just in case, please get bicycle insurance!
