Bicycles with narrow tires are particularly vulnerable to punctures. If you know how to fix a puncture by yourself, you'll be able to go far!

Ring your bell at warning signs and at places with poor visibility. Do not use your bell to tell pedestrians to get out of your way.

Bicycles must be folded and placed into bike bags when travelling on public transportation. Please note, some bus and taxi companies may not accept bicycles even if they are placed in bike bags.

Be careful of sharp curves and accidents!


Kagawa prefecture has many tight curves and narrow roads, especially in the mountains and on the
