## Enjoy Your Trip in Kagawa on Kotoden Train

**Kotoden** (officially Takamatsu-Kotohira Electric Railroad Co., Ltd.) operates three lines in Kagawa Prefecture. Using these lines, you can visit popular tourist destinations efficiently.

- Kotohira Line** Links Takamatsu-Chikkō and Kotoden-Kotohira (close to Kotohira-gu Shrine) in 62 minutes.
- Nagao Line** Links Takamatsu-Chikkō and Nagao (close to Nagao-ji Temple [87th temple on the pilgrimage route in Shikoku]) in 40 minutes.
- Shido Line** Links Kawara-machi and Kotoden-Shido (close to Shido Temple [86th temple on the pilgrimage route in Shikoku]) in 40 minutes.

You can transfer to any other line at Kawara-machi Station. Enjoy comfortable railway trips while viewing pastoral landscapes.

## To Get on a Train

- Check the route and fare to your destination.**  
At the station, look at the route map that shows fares.  
\*Adult fares in black and child fares in red figures
- Buy a ticket at a ticket vending machine.**  
Insert bills/coins into a ticket vending machine and press the button of the appropriate fare. The machine will feed a ticket and change (if any) from the lower section.  
\*You can also use an IC travel card.
- Go through a ticket gate and check the platform number.**  
After going through a ticket gate, search the platform number on the bulletin board.
- Check the train destination and get on an appropriate train.**  
When a train comes, check its destination and get on an appropriate one.  
\*Be sure to get on the right train since at some stations, up trains and down trains come to the same platform.

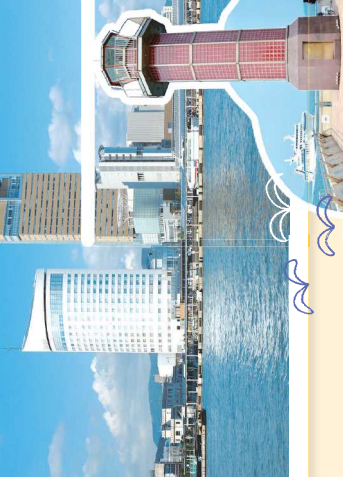
## Use IruCa IC Card!

IruCa is an IC card for Kotoden trains and buses. In addition, you can use the card for shopping and admission to public facilities.

- \*Charge a card (up to 20,000 yen) before using it.
- Various types of IC travel cards can be used at all 53 stations of the Kotohira, Nagao, and Shido lines. For details, visit Kotoden's official site.

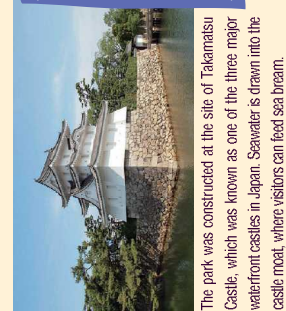


## Sunport Takamatsu

Sunport Takamatsu is a seaside district, featuring Takamatsu Port Terminal, from which ferry services are available to nearby islands famous for their artworks, a hotel, and a commercial complex. Walking along the promenade that leads to Setoshirube, the world's first glass lighthouse, you can enjoy pictorial views of the Seto Inland Sea.

## Tamamo Park (site of Takamatsu Castle)



The park was constructed at the site of Takamatsu Castle, which was known as one of the three major waterfront castles in Japan. Seawater is drawn into the castle moat, where visitors can feed sea bream.

## Takamatsu Art Museum

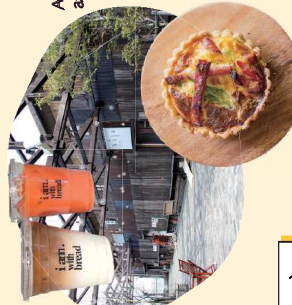

## Strolling around Busshozan

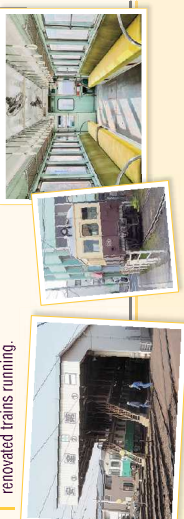

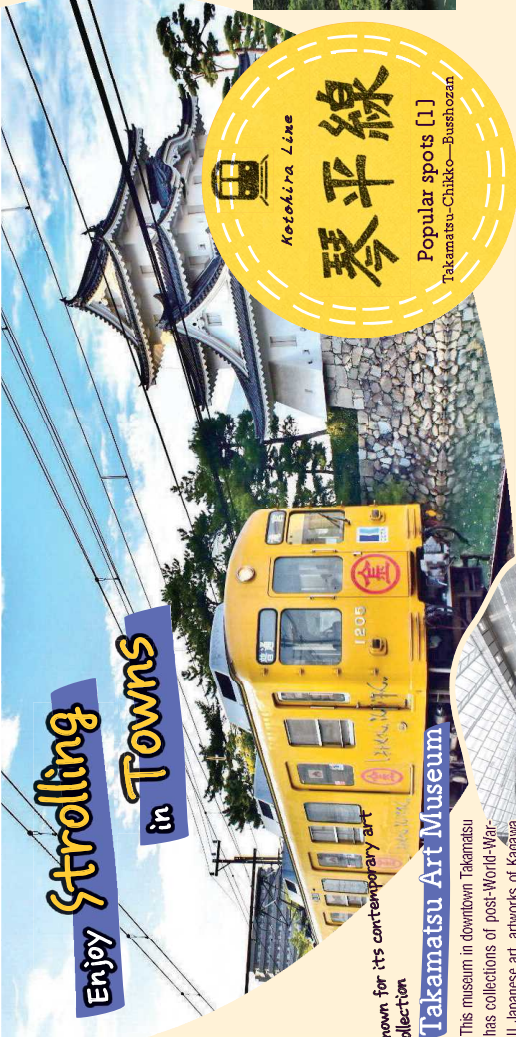
As I am a train enthusiast, I was so excited.

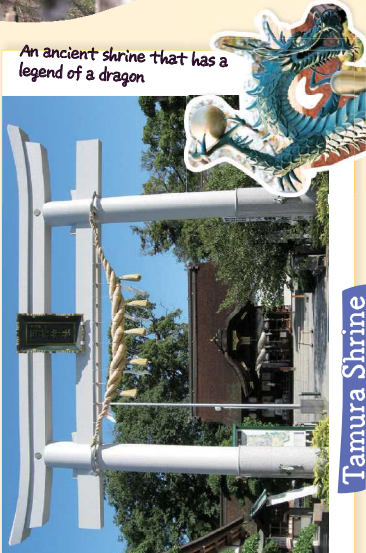

### Kotohira-gu Shrine

This is the headquarters of all Kotohira shrines in Japan. Since ancient times, the shrine deity has been worshipped as the god of the sea and a guardian deity of sailors and fishermen. Worshipers also pray for good business and a bountiful harvest. Situated on the mountainside, the shrine stands at the end of a long path, with 785 stone steps to the main shrine and a total of 1,368 steps to the inner shrine. Along the path, visitors can view various cultural assets and pictorial landscapes of each season.

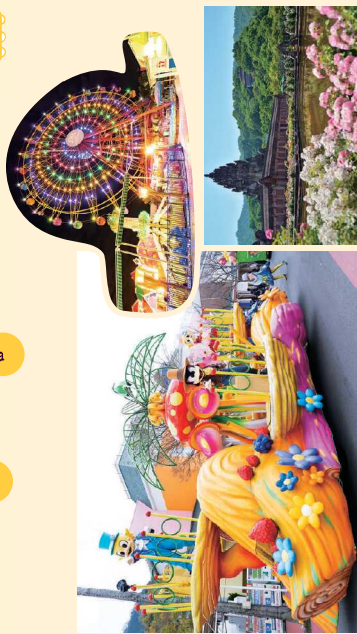

### Strolling around Shirayama

I have various favorable memories of Kagawa Prefecture, a gateway to islands in the Seto Inland Sea. This time, I visited Shirayama by train. Passengers on the Nagao Line can view pastoral landscapes that change from season to season. Around Shirayama Station, I happened to find several nice spots that are little known.



Watanabe-tei

- ☑ 2569-1 Shimotaoka, Miki-cho, Kita-gun
- (A reservation is necessary for a visit and green-tea service.)

Watanabe-tei is a time-honored residence where powdered green tea is served. In this old house, I was able to enjoy various views from diverse angles. In a Japanese-style room, for example, I noticed that paper sliding doors reflected the shimmering water surface of the nearby pond, and in the garden, I saw maple trees with foliage of different colors, ranging from green to red. Looking at peaceful landscapes, I was able to relax myself. Moreover, I appreciated the deep hospitality of the host while having a bowl of hot powdered green tea and a Japanese sweet of the season.



Tresta Shirayama

After skating, you can relax yourself in a hot spring bath. This is possible for guests staying at Tresta Shirayama, a hot spring resort hotel with a large outdoor swimming pool and an indoor ice-skating rink (the only rink in Shikoku that meets international standards). On the day I visited the rink, I saw kindergarten children enjoying skating. Even adult people who have never experienced the sport can try skating.



Shirayama Shrine

Although the shrine does not have grand structures, it is well known for its cherry blossoms in spring. Located on a hillside of Mt. Shirayama (also known as Tosan-Fuji), the shrine commands a panoramic view of the town area. Many railfans take photographs of the torii gate and a train passing below the shrine.



Shirayama has various good spots for tourists. Please enjoy sightseeing, as well as the famous Sanuki noodles.

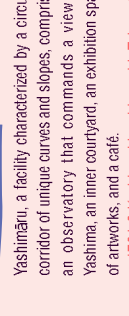
## Takamatsu City Shirobana Park



This cable car takes passengers from the foot of Mt. Goken to Yakuri-ji Temple, located halfway up the mountain. Yakuri-ji is the 85th temple on the pilgrimage route in Shikoku and is believed to have been founded by Kukai. From the cable car, passengers can enjoy magnificent views of cherry blossoms and crimson maple foliage.

Yashima, literally "roof island," can be reached without getting on a boat. The island was so named because it looks like a large roof. Yashima Station, built a century ago, looks like a guesthouse for tourists.

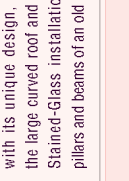

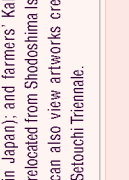
At this outdoor museum, visitors can see valuable old houses relocated from around Shikoku. The building standing by the gate is known as Oyane-san (lit. Mr. Roof). It evokes visitors' curiosity with its unique design, particularly the large curved roof and the Wooden Stained-Glass installation, made of pillars and beams of an old house.



There are many more structures to see at Shikoku Mura Museum. Among them, particularly notable are Shikoku Mura Waraya, a noodle restaurant in a renovated old farmhouse; Shikoku Mura Gallery, designed by Tadao Ando, two conical huts originally used for pressing juice from sugar cane (the only such huts extant in Japan); and farmers' Kabuki theater, relocated from Shodoshima Island. Visitors can also view artworks created for the Setouchi Triennale.

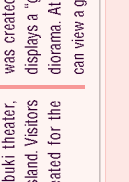
Yashimaru  
◆1784-6 Yashima-higashi-machi, Takamatsu City

Yashimaru, standing on the top of Mt. Yashima, is a circular corridor of a unique shape. The corridor has transparent glass walls and a roof covered by 30,000 granite roof tiles. It features curved slopes that go up and down in response to terrain levels. Walking inside the facility, visitors feel that they are completely enveloped by nature. The structure was created for the Setouchi Triennale 2022. The exhibition space displays a "grand panorama," comprising 360-degree oil paintings and diorama. At present, Yashimaru is the only place in Japan where you can view a grand panorama.



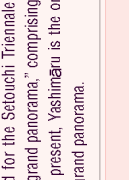

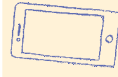

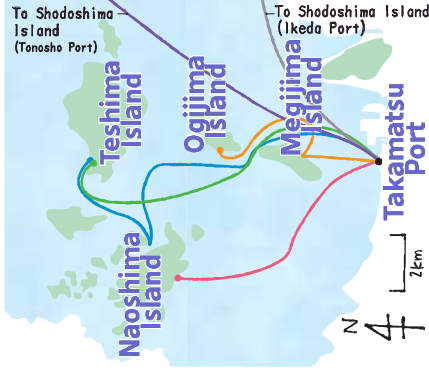
